What are some of the responsibilities of a Research Associate?

- Screen patients in the Emergency Department (ED) for existing research protocols
- Assist in obtaining informed consent from patients to participate in research protocols
- Collect data by reviewing medical records, interviewing patients, and/or direct observation
- Enter data into databases

Other opportunities include:

- Observe clinical activities in an ED setting
- Learn medical terminology and pathophysiology of certain diseases
- Actively participate in clinical research within the department

Additional Benefits: We can provide a letter of recommendation in support of the Research Associate's application to medical schools or other graduate level allied health education upon satisfactory completion of the program. Additionally, opportunities to shadow physicians in the ED are occasionally offered. Students may also be able to receive credit from their college or university for internship hours.

Requirements to apply:

- Must be able to commit eight hours per week for at least two academic semesters (including fall, spring, and summer)
- A current resume and a letter of recommendation from a faculty member or a previous employer
- This program is open to all students who have an interest in medicine or other allied health professions
