The Performance Project is an arts, social justice, and inter-generational mentoring program for youth based in Springfield. First Generation brings together youth in their teens to early twenties, from African American, Latinx, and immigrant and refugee communities for intensive artistic and leadership training, intergenerational mentoring, academic support, and social justice dialogues.

First Gen members may be the first in their family to grow up in the US, graduate high school, go to college, speak English, be incarcerated, be openly LGBTQ+, be a feminist, an activist, break a silence, be an artist, or any other firsts.

Forming an artistic ensemble, they create multilingual physical performances based on their experiences and the experiences of their families and communities that highlight local and global social justice issues. They perform in a multitude of settings — from schools and colleges, to theater and music festivals, to community centers and youth programs and social justice conferences
