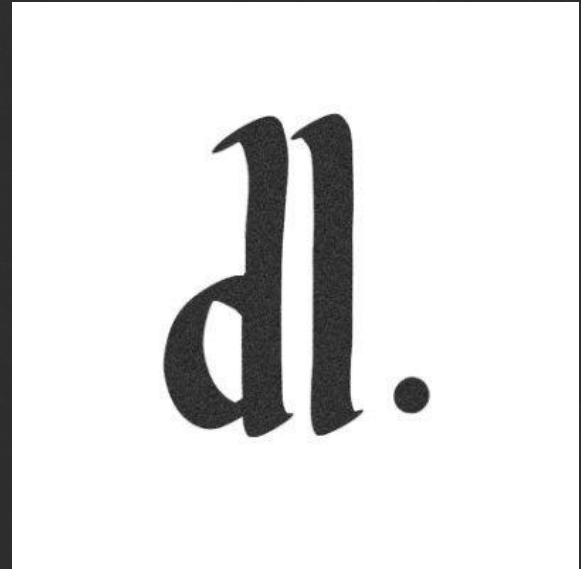




OUR FUTURE
